## Special Needs Unit Features

- All doors have at least 31" of clearance
- Bed heights 25" maximum
- Dining table knee clearance 25½"
- 42"x 47" roll-in shower
- Grab bars
- Portable bath stools
- Handheld showerhead
- Roll-under lavatory has 31" knee clearance
- 17" toilets
- Front control stove/oven
- Counter microwave
- Visual fire, phone and doorbell alarms
- Accessible 7'x 7' deck

## Resort Accessible Features

- Accessible parking
- Card key locks
- Accessible routes to all resort facilities
- Lift for pool and spa access
- Compliance kit with TDD unit and visual alarms for fire, phone and doorbell available

WorldMark Angels Camp is located on level to steeply sloping property; however, accessible parking, accommodation units and resort facilities are located in level to gently sloping areas. There are accessible routes to all major facilities. A lift is available for disabled access for both outdoor pools and three of the four outdoor spas.

## Special Needs Units

One-bedroom, one-bathroom

Two-bedroom, two-bathroom

The special needs units all have card key lock entry, lever door handles, level thresholds and 32" entry clearance. Interior doorways for the bedroom and bathroom have 31" of clearance. Bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, a 17" high toilet, 31" knee clearance under the lavatory and a 42"x 47" roll-in shower with handheld showerhead and fold down seat. Portable bath stools are available. The two-bedroom unit has a king bed with 36" access on both sides; the one-bedroom has a queen bed with 36" clearance on one bed side. Kitchens have a front control oven/stove, a counter microwave and 36" counters and sink. Dining room tables have 25½" knee clearance, and living areas have an open design. There is 32" access and flush thresholds providing access to the 7'x 7' decks.

No standard units are recommended for mobility impaired guests because most of the ground floor units have several steps to navigate and the bathroom layouts don't provide adequate space to accommodate most wheelchairs.
