

Dear WorldMark Owner/Guest:

Thank you for selecting Arrow Point for your upcoming vacation. There are a number of activities available in and around Coeur d'Alene, ranging from water fun on the lake and world-class golf to the Silverwood Theme Park.

The resort's location on Lake Coeur d'Alene provides for excellent boating opportunities. In the past, a small marina next to the resort was available for boaters, but we have been notified of its closure. At this time, we do not know if it will reopen. Please call the resort at (208) 666-0320 to learn the status of the marina and any possibility of renting slips.

WorldMark units at Arrow Point are part of a larger Homeowners' Association and as such we must live by the covenants. Due to HOA restrictions, we have no luggage carts and there are no lighted signs at night in the check-in office, which is open from 8 am to 10 pm. The office is located in Building F, unit 102. A paving stone walkway leading to the office from the parking lot is located opposite the pool building. Arrow Point has an indoor swimming pool, but no hot tub or exercise area.

Unfortunately, the resort does not offer RV or trailer parking on site. If you have plans to bring a boat, please review the information below for alternatives. Guests have the use of one parking place per unit with overflow parking near the office.

Squaw Bay (www.squawbayresort.com) is two miles north of the resort on Highway 97. They have a boat launch available for a fee and offer trailer parking. They also have on-the-water gasoline services, and you can rent boats, canoes or kayaks. Squaw Bay can be reached at (208) 664-6782. This is a seasonal business, so you may reach their voicemail when you call.

Carlin Bay Resort (www.carlinbay.com) is eight miles south of the resort on Highway 97. They have a boat launch, bar and grill, and a small convenience store as well as overnight trailer parking. There is no charge to launch a boat. Carlin Bay can be reached at (208) 689-3295.

The nearest public launch area is eight miles north on Highway 97. It is also the largest launch of the three options for large boats. If you need to launch a sailboat, a Coeur d'Alene boat launch is recommended.

The closest grocery store is 18 miles from WorldMark Arrow Point in Coeur d'Alene (Exit 12). We recommend that you buy your groceries before coming to the resort.

A restaurant is being built on the resort and is expected to open this summer.

The management and staff of Arrow Point look forward to hosting you and making yours a memorable stay. Have a wonderful vacation!

Things to See and Do in Coeur d'Alene

As its name implies, Coeur d'Alene is a city with heart. Nestled among tall pines on the shores of beautiful Lake Coeur d'Alene, this town also occupies the heart of northern Idaho. Its 100-year-old richly textured history and a population of approximately 30,000 come together to form one of the few communities in the country to be called an "All-American City."

But Coeur d'Alene has plenty of unique standouts. Consider, for one, that Northern Idaho has the greatest concentration of lakes of any western state. But there are lakes ... and then there are lakes. Lake Coeur d'Alene is 25 miles long with 135 miles of shoreline and an average depth of 120 feet. For many, the cutthroat trout and monster Chinook salmon are easily its strongest draws, but fishing hardly holds a monopoly on fun at this watersport lovers' paradise. With its placid current and distinctly Northwest environs, sailing, canoeing and boating are also incredible.

We can't go too far without mentioning the area's preeminent golf. Sixteen exciting courses are scattered throughout North Idaho. Coeur d'Alene Resort Golf Course has become famous for its Scott Miller-designed links—specifically, its

phenomenal signature hole—a floating, movable green. Consider also perfectly manicured and lavishly landscaped scenery, with junipers, geraniums and petunias, plus a wall-to-wall bent grass layout that boasts a lake view from every hole.

With the arrival of winter, snow sports seize the attention of powder-enthusiasts. Silver Mountain, just 36 miles away at Kellogg, has two mountain peaks, six lifts, 2,200 vertical feet, and the world's longest single-stage gondola, rising 3.1 miles up the mountain.

Head north and you'll run into famed 2,500-acre Schweitzer Mountain Resort outside Sandpoint. Many of its 59 trails feature breathtaking views of Lake Pend Oreille and the Selkirk Mountains. Lookout Pass Ski Area, on the Montana-Idaho border, is considered by some to be the best learning hill in the Northwest, and Farragut State Park, north of Coeur d'Alene in Athol, is a favorite among cross-country skiers.

When the summer sun warms the area up a bit, City Beach is the perfect choice for cooling off or catching some rays. Or, for more diverse water play, Wild Waters offers 11 refreshingly wet slides. Of course, there is also Idaho's

legendary whitewater. Experience it for yourself on a guided rafting expedition down the Moyie, St. Joe, Salmon, Snake and Lochsa rivers.

Adjacent to downtown Coeur d'Alene is Tubbs Hill, a gorgeous 120-acre wooded preserve. Paths lined with Douglas fir and ponderosa pine will take you to hidden coves and beaches—or up hills for panoramic views.

Nearby, the 3.3-mile Mineral Ridge Trail provides one of the best seasonal vantage points to observe migrant populations of bald eagles. There's also the North Idaho Centennial Trail, which extends all the way from Lake Coeur d'Alene to the Washington-Idaho border.

And don't forget Silverwood
Theme Park, modeled after a turn-ofthe-century Victorian town, just 15
miles north of Coeur d'Alene—with
more than 60 amusement rides and
attractions, great restaurants, unique
shops and superb live entertainment.
Or, for that matter, area specialties such
as huckleberries and beer.

But there's plenty more to discover about Coeur d'Alene. Take time to explore and see what you can find on your own.

Driving Directions

From Seattle, WA

- Take I-90 East.
- Take exit 22 off Interstate 90.
- Turn south onto Hwy 97 and travel 9.5 miles only. (The resort is not in the City of Harrison.)
- The entrance to Arrow Point Resort is on the right (sign does not say "WorldMark"). The check-in office is located in the last big building on the left. Drive down into the parking garage and park in a "Guest" space, then go through the green doors to the elevator and the check-in office is located in F5102 on the first floor.

From the South

- Take US 95 North toward Coeur d'Alene.
- Follow US 95 to I-90 East.
- Follow the directions in **bold** to the left

From the East on I-90

- Take Exit 22 (6 miles east of Coeur d'Alene).
- Take a left at the stop sign and continue south for 9.5 miles on Hwy 97
- Follow the <u>underlined</u> directions in **bold** to the left.
