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Special Needs Unit Features

- Card key lock entry
- All entry doors have at least 33" of clearance
- All doors have lever handles
- All bedrooms have at least 31" doorways
- 15"-16" toilets
- Grab bars
- A portable bath bench with back support is available
- 24" high beds
- Accessible decks
- Roll-under kitchen sinks
- Dining room table knee clearance 27"
- Front control stove/range

Resort Accessible Features

- Accessible parking
- Lowered check-in counter
- TDD unit available
- Lift access for pool and spa
- Accessible routes to recreation and fitness center, game room, outdoor pool, three spas, children's pool, playground and tennis and basketball courts

Big Bear is located on level to gently sloping property. The resort offers handicap parking, a 34" check-in counter for disabled access and numerous paved trails throughout the property. There is a lift for disabled access to the outdoor pool and three outdoor spas, as well as accessible routes to all resort features. A TDD unit is available upon request.

Special Needs Units

One bedroom, one bathroom
Two bedroom, two bathroom

All special needs units feature card key lock entry, lever door handles and level thresholds. All entry doors have at least 33" of clearance. The one-bedroom unit has a 33" bedroom door, but clearance on one bed side is only 28" and there is only 27" access into the bathroom. The two-bedroom unit has at least 31" access to the bedroom and bathroom. Bathrooms have 15"-16" toilets, grab bars, hand held shower heads and 15" standard tub/showers with curtains. A portable bath bench with back support is also available. The kitchen features roll-under sinks and front control stoves/ranges. Living rooms are open and decks have 33" entries, 1" thresholds and deck tables with 27" of knee clearance.

Though not specifically designed for special needs, the ground floor standard two-bedroom units represent the most accessible alternative. These units are similar to the special needs two-bedroom units and have bathrooms large enough to accommodate most wheelchairs.
