Things to See and Do at Bison Ranch

With all there is to do at Bison Ranch, there's hardly any need to step foot off the property in search of a good time. Charming WorldMark units sit atop **quaint period shops**, such as **Ronna Lea's Country Boutique**, **Twinnie's Coffee Break**, **Bison Ranch Country Furniture** and **Purple Sage**. Take a stroll through the courtyard and sit in the gazebo. During the summer, there'll be chances to enjoy rodeos on the back plot or cowboy cookouts. (Please call the resort ahead of time to find out what is happening during your stay.)

The complex is enveloped in woodland, backed up on three sides by the **Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest**. Some of the most spectacular scenery in the Southwest awaits forest wanderers throughout the two million acres of Apache-Sitgreaves forestland. Wander by foot or horseback through the pines and high-country prairie; you might encounter elk, bald eagles, pronghorn antelope, coyotes, bear, fox, bighorn sheep, cougars and bobcats—

all residents of Arizona's high country. Or make a stop at one of the lovely surrounding lakes and discover the thrill of landing a mountain bass.

While Bisontown is not short on entertainment, the nature-packed playground it resides in is compelling. Only 130 miles from Phoenix, the mountain air is invigorating and offers a reprieve from the southern Arizona sun. The **White Mountains** are dotted with historical sites, each one within driving distance of WorldMark at Bison Ranch. The **Kinishba Ruins**, containing more than 200 rooms, are more than 1,000 years old. At **Lyman Lake State Park**, you can hike a one-mile trail lined with petroglyphs; Anasazi Indians from 300 B.C. have been credited as the artists. Visit **Casa Malpais**—House of the Badlands—Archaeological Park. Here you can examine 800-year-old traces of a Mogollon pueblo, including a hidden staircase to the cliff top, large kiva, tether rock, ceremonial plaza, petroglyphs and underground fissures.

To explore a historical site of more recent history, stop at **Fort Apache**, which was home to the First and Twenty-first Infantry during the time of Geronimo and Cochise.

Investigate the world's largest concentration of petrified wood at the **Petrified Forest National Park**. This 300-square-mile park also includes sections of the Painted Desert, with clay formations sculpted by wind and an ancient sea. Visit the "mini-Grand Canyon," **Canyon de Chelly**. Lofty mesas, multi-colored buttes, spires and rock walls adorn the canyon. To stretch your legs after the drive, descend 2,000 feet to the floor of the canyon via a series of switchbacks.

In case you're wondering why this resort is called Bison Ranch ... well, that's easy. Until recently, wild bison lived in the area, but they have since been relocated to another community.

Driving Directions

From the west (Phoenix, AZ):

- Take the Hwy 202 Loop East from Phoenix to US 87 North to Payson.
- In Payson turn right onto Hwy 260 East.
- Drive 54 miles to Heber/Overgaard.
- **Bison Ranch is located off Hwy 260 on the right, just before mile marker 310. The check-in office is located in a green one-story building.**

From the east (I-40 westbound):

- Follow I-40 West to Holbrook and take Exit 286.
- Drive south through town on Hwy 77 and turn right onto Hwy 377.
- Continue 34 miles to Hwy 277 and turn right.
- Continue 8 miles to Heber/Overgaard and turn left onto Hwy 260. Follow the directions in **bold** above.

From the north (I-40 eastbound):

- Take US 89 South to Flagstaff, then I-40 East to Holbrook.
- Take Hwy 77 South to Hwy 377.
- Turn right at junction onto Hwy 277.
- Take Hwy 277 South to Hwy 260.
- Turn left at junction onto Hwy 260.
- Take Hwy 260 East to just past milepost 309.
- **Bison Ranch is on the right, just beyond the bison corral. The check-in office is located in a green one-story building.**

From St. George, UT:

- Take I-15 to Hwy 9.
- Continue on Hwy 89 to Flagstaff.
- Follow the directions from the north above.
