Special Needs Unit Features

- Card key lock entry
- All entry doors have at least 33" of clearance
- All entry doors have lever handles
- All interior door widths 33"
- Roll-in showers
- 29" roll-under lavatories
- 16" toilets
- Grab bars
- A portable bath bench with back support is available
- 22"-24" high beds
- Dining room table knee clearance 28"
- Minimum of 36" access on both bed sides
- Patio access of at least 32" with 1"-2" thresholds

Resort Accessible Features

- Accessible parking
- Lift access for pool and spa
- Accessible routes to all resort amenities
- Elevators

Transportation to WorldMark Coral Baja is one of the greatest obstacles for mobility impaired guests. Guests arriving by air will need to be prepared to be carried down steps in an isle chair. There are no wheelchair accessible buses, taxis, car rentals or other means of public transportation. However, taxi drivers and resort staff will physically lift mobility impaired guests into taxi-vans and do whatever else is necessary to transport them to their desired location. The resort is located on level to gently sloping property with wheelchair accessible routes to all guest units and resort amenities. There are no TDD units, Braille signage, visual alarms or other devices to assist hearing or visually impaired.

Special Needs Units

One bedroom, one bathroom
Two bedroom, two bathroom

All special needs units have card key lock entry, lever door handles and level thresholds. All entry doors have at least 33" of clearance and interior door widths of 33". Bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, 16" toilets, 29" of knee clearance under lavatories, at least 34"x48" roll-in showers with grab bars and hand held shower heads. A portable bath bench with back support is also available. Bedrooms have at least 36" of clearance on both bed sides. Kitchens are open with 36" counters and rear control appliances. Living areas are open and spacious. The large patios have at least 32" access with thresholds of 1"-2" and patio tables with 27" of knee clearance.

Though all standard units have ground floor or elevator access and 33" entries, bedroom door widths are as narrow as 28" and bathroom door widths are as narrow as 23". The standard two-bedroom unit is the most accessible alternative with a bathroom design large enough to accommodate most wheelchairs able to navigate the 25" bathroom entry width.
