# On the Way to Clear Lake

*This section includes points of interest and side trips along the way to the resort. For the most direct route, see “Driving Directions” below.*

## From San Francisco, CA (fast route)

*Drive north on US 101 ...*

In Petaluma, head for **Petaluma Adobe State Historic Park**, featuring a large adobe ranch house built in 1836. Exhibits include clothing and tools from that period. Self-guided tours are available, detailing the town’s 19th-century buildings and Victorian homes.

Try this one for size! The **Church of One Tree/Believe It Or Not! Ripley Memorial Museum** was built from a single redwood tree. The beautiful grounds of **Luther Burbank Home and Gardens** describe the work of this horticulturist who introduced 800 varieties of plants.

Notable wineries are in the **Healdsburg** area. Tasting and tours are offered at **Johnson’s Alexander Valley Wines**, which contains a 1925 theater pipe organ. **Simi Winery** also offers tours and a tasting room.

*Continue north on US 101 to Hwy 20 and head east to Nice ...*

**Upper Lake** is a small, days-of-yesteryear community. One of the oldest settlements in Lake County, it

was a frontier, logging and ranching town. There are a number of antique shops and art galleries to explore. **Nice**, home to your **WorldMark at Clear Lake** resort, and the surrounding area is often called the “Switzerland of America” because of the terrain and steep **Bartlett Mountain Range** resembling the Alps. On the shores of Clear Lake, **Nice** boasts peaceful rural scenery with great watersport activities, as well as local award-winning wineries.

## From San Francisco, CA (scenic)

*Take US 101 North to Hwy 37 East, then follow Hwy 37 to the junction of Hwy 29 North into the Napa Valley ...*

**Napa** and the **Napa Valley**, California’s most famous wine-producing region, began in the 1850s as a Gold Rush center. **Hot-air balloon rides** are available through several companies. The **Napa Valley Wine Train** offers a 36-mile journey through the heart of this wine country.

Heading north on Hwy 29, you will travel through **Yountville**, where you will find **The Vintage 1870**, a shopping and dining complex in a restored 19th-century winery. **Oakville** is home to the famous **Robert Mondavi Winery**. A little farther north, **Rutherford** includes

the popular **Inglennook Winery**. On your way to **St. Helena**, visit another favorite—**Sutter Home**. The **Hurd Beeswax Candle Factory** produces hand-crafted candles. **Bale Grist Mill State Historic Park** features an 1847 working grinding mill with a 36-foot diameter wheel. **Beringer Winery** is located in **St. Helena**. In all, more than 160 wineries are located in the **Napa Valley** region.

*At Calistoga, continue north on Highway 29, then head west, still on 29 North, to Highway 20 ...*

**Old Faithful Geyser** of California, in **Calistoga**, is one of the world’s few regularly erupting geysers. It erupts about every 40 minutes, spewing water 60 feet into the air. The **Petrified Forest** preserves the giant petrified redwoods. At the lower end of Clear Lake, 1,000-acre **Anderson Marsh State Historic Park** protects several habitats and more than 150 bird species. More than half of the park has been designated as a natural preserve.

*At Hwy 20, head east to Nice ...*  
On your way to **Nice**, enjoy exploring the communities of **Clearlake Oaks**, **Glenhaven** and **Lucerne**.

## Driving Directions

### From San Francisco, CA

- Head north on US 101 through Ukiah to Hwy 20.
- Turn right and drive east on Hwy 20 to **Nice**, approximately 26 miles.
- The resort is on the right hand side about 1 1/2 miles beyond the **Sentry Market**.

### From Sacramento, CA

- Take I-5 North to **Williams**.
- At **Williams**, take Hwy 20 West through the town of **Lucerne** to **Nice**.
- At **Nice**, continue approximately 1/2 mile. **WorldMark Clear Lake** is on your left.

### From Redding, CA

- Drive south on I-5 to the Hwy 20 exit, just before the town of **Williams**.
- Turn right and head west on Hwy 20 through **Lucerne** to **Nice**.
- In approximately 1/2 mile, you will see the resort on your left.

### From Eureka, CA

- Drive south on US 101 to the Hwy 20 exit, just before the town of **Ukiah**.
- Turn left and follow the bold directions to the left.
