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Special Needs Unit Features

- All entries have at least 33” of clearance
- All essential interior doors have at least 31” of clearance
- All doors have lever handles
- Four of the two-bedroom units have 34”x59” roll-in showers and 29” knee clearance on roll-under lavatories
- The four units without roll-in showers have tub/showers with fold down bath benches and 26”-27” of knee clearance on roll-under lavatories
- 17”-18” high toilets
- Grab bars
- A portable bath bench with back support is available
- 25” high beds
- Dining room table knee clearance 24”
- 40” access on one bed side
- Front control stove/range
- Counter microwaves in four of the two-bedroom units
- Visual fire alarms

Resort Accessible Features

- Accessible parking
- Accessible route to check-in area and all resort facilities
- Pool lift
- Elevators
- TDD units available

Depoe Bay offers handicap parking, accessible routes to the WorldMark check-in area and all resort facilities. The surrounding property is level to gently sloping. A lift is available for access to all outdoor pools, the indoor pool and two spas. All units have elevator access. Special needs units have ground floor access and are equipped with visual fire alarms. A TDD unit is available upon request.

Special Needs Units

Two bedroom, two bathroom
Three bedroom, three bathroom

All special needs units feature standard key entries, lever door handles and level thresholds. All doorways have at least 31” of clearance. Bathrooms are equipped with 17”-18” toilets and at least 26” of knee clearance under lavatories. Four of the units feature standard tub/showers with hand held showers, grab bars and fold down benches. Four of the two-bedroom units feature 32”x59” roll-in showers. A portable bath bench with back support is also available. Accessible bedrooms have at least 40” access on at least one bed side. The kitchens sport front control stoves/ranges and counter microwaves. Patios and decks have at least 30” access and thresholds that range between 1.5” and 3.5”.

Though almost all standard units have ground floor or elevator access and 33” entries, they are generally not recommended for mobility impaired guests because interior doorways are as narrow as 24” and the bathrooms are not large enough to accommodate most wheelchairs.
