On the Way to Eagle Crest

This section includes points of interest and side trips along the way to the resort. For the most direct route, see "Driving Directions" below.

From Portland, OR

Drive east on Hwy 26 ...

The Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs have assembled one of the richest tribal collections in the nation, with life-size dioramas and multimedia exhibits in The Museum at Warm Springs. The Kah-Nee-Ta Resort is famous for its hot springs and world-class fishing.

Go south from Madras on Hwy 97...

Cove Palisades State Park is a pleasant stop. The Metolius, Deschutes and Crooked rivers converge in a massive reservoir, with great fishing, hiking, swimming and picnic areas. Traveling farther south, you'll spy Smith Rock. Here you'll find a state park dedicated to climbing, with majestic spires and sheer walls that rise above the Crooked River. On your way to Smith Rock, be sure to stop at the Peter Skene Ogden Scenic Wayside for a stunning view of the dramatic gorge carved by the Crooked River.

Go west on Hwy 126...

For a scenic detour during the summer months, take a two-and-a-half hour loop to Mckenzie Pass. Drive west on Hwy 126 through the west-ern-themed town of Sisters and then head west on Hwy 242. Be sure to stop at the breathtaking Sahalie Falls, two waterfalls with foaming whitewater in between.

From Salem, OR

Head east on Hwy 22, then east on Hwy 126 ...

A fun stop for the family is the Metolius Recreation Area and picturesque Camp Sherman. The Metolius is one of the nation's largest spring-fed rivers. For fun in the forest, get out your bicycle, running shoes or hiking boots. Wonderful trails and old roads wind past Ponderosa-lined lakes.

From Eugene, OR

Heading east, take Hwy 58 ... Strike out on the breathtaking 89-mile Cascade Lakes Highway loop, with spectacular panoramas and inviting views of some 17 different lakes, plus the picture-postcard beauty of the Three Sisters Mountains.

From Klamath Falls, OR

Heading north on Hwy 97 ...

The massive volcano of Newberry National Volcanic Monument includes a five-mile wide caldera encompassing obsidian fields, deep mountain lakes, lava formations and waterfalls. Follow a narrow dirt road to the top of Paulina Peak for a breathtaking view of Newberry Crater.

A few miles farther north on Highway 97, the Central Oregon Desert comes to life through nationallyrenowned exhibits, interactive displays and wildlife presentations at the The **High Desert Museum.** You can walk through more than 100 years of history here.

Mt. Bachelor is known for the best skiing in the Pacific Northwest. The ski area's Summit Lift is also open in the summer to foot passengers. Ride the lift both ways or ride up and hike back down. From the awesome 9,065-foot peak, you'll enjoy a dramatic 360-degree view, allowing you to see both Washington and California landmarks on clear days.

Driving Directions

From the north:

- Take I-5 South to Portland.
- Take the I-205/Salem exit and drive south on I-205 to Hwy 26.
- Take the Hwy 26/Gresham exit and drive east on Hwy 26 over Mt. Hood to Madras.
- At Madras, take Hwy 97 South to Redmond.
- In Redmond, turn right onto Glacier Ave/Hwy 126 toward Sisters and continue west about five miles, taking the first right after the overpass. This will take you across the overpass and onto Cline Falls Hwy.
- Follow the signs to the Inn at Eagle Crest, approximately 1 mile.

From the south:

- Take I-5 North to Weed, California. Take Hwy 97 North through Bend to Redmond, OR.
- In Redmond, turn left on Glacier Ave/Hwy 126 toward Sisters. See the directions in **bold** to the left.

From the west:

- At the east end of Sisters, turn left onto Hwy 126 toward Redmond.
- Approximately 15 miles from Sisters, turn right before the overpass onto Cline Falls Hwy.
- Continue south to Eagle Crest.
- Follow the signs to the Inn at Eagle Crest.
