

#### Dear WorldMark Owner/Guest:

Thank you for selecting Gleneden Beach for your upcoming vacation. Gleneden Beach is the perfect place to experience the Oregon Coast. It is one of the first WorldMark Resorts built from the ground up, with spectacular landscaping and over seven miles of beach access. There are a number of activities available in and around Gleneden Beach, ranging from beachcombing for agates, blowing your own glass floats, whale watching, deep-sea fishing, shopping and sightseeing.

There are two buildings at Gleneden Beach. The front building has three stories and consists of a north (Sand Dollar) and south (Starfish) section. This building wraps around the pool and spa, which are open year round. The back building has three stories and is known as Sea Breeze. Starfish and Sand Dollar both have elevators and 65% of the units have a view. Sea Breeze does not have an elevator and 65% of the units have a distant view of the ocean.

Gleneden Beach is located between Lincoln City and Depoe Bay. Following are directions to the resort:

**Driving South on Highway 101** – continue through Lincoln City, over the Siletz River, and past Kernville. The first stoplight after the Kernville exit is located at the Salishan Golf & Spa Resort. There will be a golf course on your left, and a brown shopping plaza on your right. Turn right immediately after Salishan at the green Gleneden Beach sign. Bear left as the road forks (there will be a sign on your right saying "Gleneden Beach Loop"). We are located approximately half a mile down this road on the right hand side. If you pass the Gleneden Fire Station you have gone too far.

**Driving North on Highway 101 -** continue on Highway 101 thru Newport and Depoe Bay, past the Italian Riviera Restaurant and Sentry Market. Drive slowly over the hill and turn left on Wessler Street (on the right hand side of Highway 101 there is a "Gleneden Beach Park" sign where you would turn left on Wessler). If you pass Salishan Golf Resort and Spa, you have gone too far. After turning left on Wessler Street, turn right immediately onto Gleneden Beach Loop. The entrance to the resort is on the left immediately past the Gleneden Beach Fire Station.

- Check in time is at 4:00 pm. If you call the Front Desk at 541-764-3854 on the day of your arrival, we can take your cell phone number and call you when your room is ready if it happens to be before 4:00 pm.
- Checkout time is at 12:00 pm.
- Fresh towels and additional supplies are available 24 hours a day at the Front Desk.
- The resort features a recreation center with exercise equipment, a tennis court, spa, pool table, ping pong table, air hockey, arcade games, and a big screen television.
- There are daily on-site activities, including bonfires on the beach, bingo nights, and barbeques.
- The nearest grocery store is Sentry Market, located 1 mile south of the resort on Highway 101.
- In our lobby there are coupons and discount passes for golfing, shopping, restaurants and local attractions.
- Cell-phone coverage is spotty at best.



The Front Desk is open 24 hours a day. We invite you to stop by or give us a call. We will be happy to answer your questions and provide you with any additional information you might need.

# On the Way to Gleneden

This section includes points of interest and side trips along the way to the resort. For the most direct route, see the driving directions below.

#### From Eugene, OR

From I-5, drive west on Hwy 126...
The "City of Rhododendrons"—
Florence—explodes with color in late spring. Explore the historic shops and buildings of Old Town. Florence is also the northern gateway to the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area, which you can tour by dune buggy.

Continue north on US 101...

Explore rocky tide pools or the coastal rain forest from 17 miles of hiking trails at Cape Perpetua Scenic Area. The cape rises 800 feet above the Pacific Ocean, providing a spectacular view of the coastline. The rocky chasm of Devil's Churn is fascinating in summer and awe inspiring during winter storms—an excellent spot for photographers. Take the auto tour to the Cape Perpetua Viewpoint.

Besides beach access and picnic facilities, the Seal Rock Wayside offers geologic attractions due to exposed faults in the rocks. Lost Creek State Park has a wheelchair-accessible trail to the beach. The Hatfield Marine Science

Center offers informative displays and intriguing marine animals, some of which you can touch! One of Oregon's most popular attractions, the Oregon Coast Aquarium, includes four indoor galleries that showcase coastal habitats. Outdoors, seals, sea lions and otters play in rocky pools, while birds soar and dive in North America's largest walk-through seabird aviary.

### From Corvallis, OR

Drive west on US 20 ...

The town of Newport offers gift shops, galleries, restaurants and an extensive variety of fresh seafood. It also serves up other attractions: The Undersea Gardens and the Wax Works Museum, for instance. The Nye Beach Historic District houses the Yaquina Art Museum, the Newport Performing Arts Center and the Newport Visual Arts Center.

The often-photographed Yaquina Head Lighthouse, built in 1873, stands on an outcropping of rock jutting into the ocean just north of Newport. Wheelchair accessible tide pools have been created off the lighthouse access road. Cape Foulweather was named by Captain James Cook on a particularly inclement day in 1778.

#### From Portland, OR

Drive south on US 101 ...

The rugged beauty of the Coast Range, Haystack Rock and the Needles has turned Cannon Beach into an artist and photographer mecca. Much of their work can be admired in this seaside town's many galleries and shops. Kite flying, beach-combing and tide pool exploring around Haystack Rock are very popular activities.

Continue south on US 101 ...

Tillamook is home to Oregon's largest cheese factory. The Tillamook County Creamery Association attracts nearly a million visitors each year! The Blue Heron Cheese Factory is also a great stop, as is the Tillamook County Pioneer Museum.

#### From Salem, OR

Drive north on US 101 ...

With more than seven miles of beaches for kite flying, Lincoln City has claimed the title "Kite Flying Capital of the World." Shop in the galleries, antique shops and factory outlet stores. Devil's Lake State Park offers boating and picnicking.

# **Driving Directions**


#### From the north:

- Take I-5 South to Salem and the Salem Pkwy exit.
- Travel through Salem to the Marion Street Bridge/Ocean Beaches sign, staying in the center lane.
- Travel over the bridge in one of the two left lanes and take Hwy 22 to Hwy 18 (follow signs to Lincoln City/Ocean Beaches).
- Take Hwy 18 West 52 miles to US 101 South.
- Approximately 12 miles south of the 18/101 interchange you will notice the Westin Salishan Golf Shop. Turn right onto Gleneden Beach Loop.
- Go 7/10 of a mile to the WorldMark sign on the right.

• Follow the check-in signs to the main lobby.

# From the south:

- Take I-5 North to Hwy 34 to Corvallis.
- Proceed west on Hwy 20, following the signs to Newport.
- Hwy 20 will intersect with US 101 at Newport.
- Turn right on US 101 and follow for approximately 19 miles.
- Watch for the Gleneden State Park sign, and turn left on Wessler St, and then make an immediate right onto Gleneden Beach Loop Rd.
- The WorldMark sign is on the left. Follow the check-in signs to the main lobby.



(Note: if you reach the Westin Salishan while traveling north on Hwy 101, you have gone too far.)
