Things to See and Do in Grand Lake

Please note: Many area activities are seasonal.

Grand Lake O' the Cherokees contains 60,000 surface acres of water and 1,300 miles of shoreline. The careful balance of the lake is controlled by the **Pensacola Dam**, the largest multiple arch dam in the world. Tours of the dam are available free from Memorial Day to Labor Day; to get there from Afton, take Hwy 85 South to Hwy 82 and the town of Langley.

The Grand Lake area abounds with water activities, and your resort is located right at the heart of the action. The **Sail Grand Waterfront**, located only a half mile from your WorldMark homebase, offers waterskiing and parasailing, and you can rent Waverunners, boats or sail boards (918-257-6000). Fishing guide service is available through Shangri La Guide Service (918-964-0049). Game fish in the area include largemouth bass, spotted bass, crappie, catfish and spoonbill. For those who like their boats to be a bit more accomodating, there's the **Cherokee Queen Riverboat**. This 108 foot paddleboat, moored just across the Sailboat Bridge in Grove, includes a restaurant and dancefloor. Call 918-786-4272 for details and schedules. Or, if you're so inclined, you

can also rent a yacht yourself at Taylor Made Cruises in Afton (918-257-4448)

Relaxation is easy to come by on the shores of Grand Lake. **Island Health and Wellness Spa** (918-257-5998) offers a full range of spa services, including massage, wraps and facials. **Image Expo** (918-257-4771) offers massage, tanning and salon services. Monkey Island is home to many fine restaurants. **Ozzie's** and **Island Joe's** offer lake views. Other island dining options include **Shebang's**, **The Road House** and **Anna's Bananas**. You can find great dining options off the island in Grove at the 'Lil Cafe and the **Rheingarten**.

Other area attractions include Darryl Starbird's **National Rod & Custom Car Hall of Fame** (918-257-4234). Featuring custom cars and celebrating the people who created them, this lakeside museum is home to more than 40 exotic vehicles owned by Starbird and other renowned custom car builders. The museum is located in Afton on Hwy 85A and is open March through October, Wed-Sat, 11 a.m.-5 p.m. Your itch for history can be scratched at the **Har-Ber Village** in Grove, a recreated turn of the century (that's the 19th to 20th) town that demonstrates how the settlers of this

part of Oklahoma lived. Visit a print shop, complete with hand-operated presses, a bank and a mill, and then, if you dare, explore an old jail cell and dentist's office. You'll also find more than 100 shops and stores to explore. Located in Grove, Har-Ber Village is open seven days a week from March 1 to October 15; call 918-786-6446 for details.

Lendonwood Gardens in Grove is a three-acre public botanical garden with more than 1,400 different types of plants. Volunteers help maintain the garden, and a self-guided tour of the property is almost as much a lesson in backyard gardening as a chance to wallow in the amazing assortment of colors and textures. Visit in April to see the explosion of azaleas and dogwoods; in fall, explore the incredibly diverse world of chrysanthemums.

The **American White Pelican** stops by during its fall and spring migrations, and Grand Lake celebrates with an annual Pelican Festival in late September. This large white bird with an enormous bill and crested head can often be seen from the Sailboat Bridge near Grove, in Carey Bay just west of Grove, in Horse Creek near Bernice and just below the Pensacola Dam on the Grove River.

Driving Directions

From Tulsa, OK:

- From the airport exit, follow signs to I-244 East.
- Take I-244 East to I-44 East. *The majority of I-44 through Oklahoma is a toll road.*
- Take I-44 East 51 miles to Exit 302, Afton.
- Exit 302 right (Afton-Grove)
- From the toll booth take exit ramp to the right; travel 0.2 miles and merge onto 59S/60W/69S
- Travel 0.9 miles to 59S, turn left (landmark is Citgo)
- Travel 5.5 miles to Hwy 125; turn right (landmark is Dr. Nicklas, Ophthalmologist billboard)

- Travel 10.7 miles to WorldMark, Grand Lake. We are the first buildings on the left past the stop sign.

From St. Louis, MO:

- Take I-44 West to Exit 302, Afton, OK. *The majority of I-44 through Oklahoma is a toll road.*
- Follow the bold directions on the left.

From Kansas City, MO:

- Take Hwy 71 South all the way to Oklahoma and I-44.
- Get onto I-44 West to Exit 302, Afton. *The majority of I-44 through Oklahoma is a toll road.*
- Follow the bold directions to the left.
