On the Way to Indio

This section includes points of interest and side trips along the way to the resort. For the most direct route, see "Driving Directions" below.

From Los Angeles, CA

Drive east on I-10 ...

The San Bernardino Mountains and National Forest form a barrier between the coast and the desert, making this the perfect place for fishing, hiking, boating, or a quiet picnic. Mt. San Gogonia, the highest point, rises to 11,052 feet, with many other peaks reaching more than 10,000 feet.

The Asistencia Mission de San Gabriel in Redlands demonstrates the importance of missions in the history of colonial California. Built in 1830, the mission houses early pioneer exhibits, historic scenes of the valley and incorporates traditional adobe architecture.

From San Diego, CA

Head north on I-15 ...

Dubbed one of the nation's great city parks, San Diego's Balboa Park

features playgrounds, lawn bowling courts, gardens, museums, theaters, an aerospace center and the world-famous San Diego Zoo.

Best seen on foot, San Diego's Old Town offers nostalgic shopping emporiums, tours of restored adobes and fantastic dining. Thirty miles north is Escondido and the San Diego Wild Animal Park. More than 3,500 animals roam this roughly 2,000-acre preservation for endangered species.

Continue north on I-15, then east on Hwy 76 ...

Founded in 1816, Mission San Antonio de Pala is one of the few operating missions in California. It is located on the Pala Indian Reservation and still ministers to Native Americans.

Continue north on I-15 ...

You'll find many fine wineries in Temecula and its surrounding valley. Called the "Napa Valley of Southern California," the area features 21 wineries—many award-winning. The town of Perris is home to the Orange Empire Railway Museum. Enjoy more

than 200 rail vehicles and pieces of offrail equipment, as well as railroad and trolley memorabilia.

Continuing north to Riverside, at the junction with I-10 ...

In Riverside, kids of all ages will enjoy Castle Park, featuring an 80-year-old Dentzel carousel with hand-carved animals, rides, miniature golf courses, magic shows, and a video arcade. For photo buffs, the California Museum of Photography houses a large collection of photographic equipment and an interactive gallery.

Traveling east on I-10...

Escape the desert heat with a trip to Knott's Soak City U.S.A. in nearby Palm Springs, with 14 waterslides, a massive wave pool, and a lazy river.

Traveling east on I-10, then north on Hwy 62...

Explore the high desert at Joshua Tree National Monument, a magnificent desert sanctuary. View some of the most unusual and beautiful plants and wildlife in California, including the Joshua Tree itself.

Driving Directions

From Palm Springs Airport

- Exit the airport.
- Turn left onto S El Cielo Rd.
- Turn left onto E Ramon Rd.
- Merge onto I-10 E.
- Exit at Golf Center Pkwy.
- Turn left onto Golf Center Pkwy.
- Stay on Golf Center Pkwy. for approximately 1 mile.
- Turn right onto Via Terra Lago Way.
- Turn left onto WorldMark Way.

From Los Angeles, CA

- Take I-10 East out of Riverside to Golf Center Pkwy exit.
- Follow directions in **bold** above.

From Phoenix, AZ

- Take I-10 West out of Phoenix for approx. 245 miles.
- When you get to Indio, exit at Golf Center Pkwy.
- Turn right onto Golf Center Pkwy.
- Stay on Golf Center Pkwy. for approximately 1 mile.
- Turn right onto Via Terra Lago Way.
- Turn left onto WorldMark Way.
