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Special Needs Unit Features

- All doors have at least 33" of clearance
- Interior door widths are 33"
- All doors have lever handles
- Front control stove/range
- 32" kitchen counter section
- Counter microwaves
- Side-by-side, front-loading washer/dryers
- Dining room table knee clearance 28"
- Accessible decks
- 36" access on both sides of beds
- Bed heights 26"
- 28" roll-under lavatories
- Portable bath benches and seats available
- Special needs three-bedroom and one special needs two-bedroom units have roll-in showers
- 18" high toilets
- Grab bars

Resort Accessible Features

- Accessible parking
- Lowered registration counter

Kihei is located on level to gently sloping property and has a registration desk that has a section with a 29" high counter. All but eight units at the resort (located on the upper floor of buildings one, two and three) have roll-in or elevator access. The resort has handicapped parking and accessible routes to all facilities, and the swimming pool has a lift for disabled access.

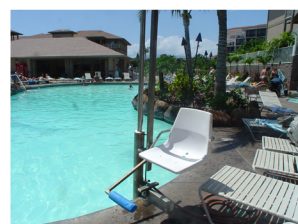
Special Needs Units

Six one-bedroom, one-bathroom (group code 51)
Eight two-bedroom, two-bathroom (group code 52)
Two three-bedroom, two-bathroom (group code 53)

All special needs units have card key locks, lever door handles, level thresholds and entry doors with 33" of clearance. Interior door widths are 33"; bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, 18" high toilets, lavatories with 28" knee clearance and tubs/showers with grab bars, bath benches, hand-held showerheads and shower curtains. In addition, the three-bedroom and one of the two-bedroom units have 32"x58" roll-in showers, but one-bedroom units do not. Three different styles of portable bath benches and seats are also available. Bedrooms have at least 36" clearance on both sides of the bed. The kitchens all have a 32" high section of counter, front-control appliances and counter microwaves, and all special needs units are equipped with side-by-side, front loading washer/dryers. Living areas are open, and the 7'x10' decks have 33" wide doorways.

The best alternatives to special needs units are the standard two- and three-bedroom units because they have similar floor plans, 33" doorways and bathrooms with 4'x7' maneuvering space—large enough to accommodate most wheelchairs.
