# On the Way to Palm Springs

## From Los Angeles, CA

*Drive east on I-10 ...*

The **San Bernardino Mountains** and **National Forest** forms a barrier between the coast and the desert. The highest peak, **Mt. San Geronimo**, rises to 11,052 feet, with many other peaks reaching more than 10,000 feet. Enjoy fishing, hiking, boating or a quiet picnic.

The **Asistencia Mission de San Gabriel** in Redlands demonstrates the importance of missions in the history of colonial California. Built in 1830, it includes early pioneer exhibits, historic scenes of the valley and traditional adobe architecture.

## From San Diego, CA

*Head north on I-15 ...*

One of the nation's great city parks, San Diego's **Balboa Park**, includes playgrounds, lawn bowling courts, gardens, museums, theaters, an aerospace center and the world-famous **San Diego Zoo**.

**Old Town** is a combination of old and new San Diego. Best seen on foot, it offers nostalgic shopping emporiums, tours of restored adobes and fantastic dining. Thirty miles north is Escondido

and the **San Diego Wild Animal Park**. More than 2,400 animals roam this 2,100-acre preservation area for endangered species.

*Continue north on I-15, then east on Hwy 76 ...*

One of the few operating missions in California, **Mission Asistencia San Antonio de Pala**, was founded in 1816. It is located on the **Pala Indian Reservation** and still ministers to Native Americans.

*Continue north on I-15 ...*

Tour many fine **wineries** in **Temecula** and its surrounding valley. Called the "Napa Valley of Southern California," the area features 12 award-winning wineries. The town of Perris is home to the **Orange Empire Railway Museum**. Enjoy more than 150 rail vehicles and pieces of off-rail equipment, as well as railroad and trolley memorabilia.

*Continuing north to Riverside, at the junction with I-10 ...*

In **Riverside**, the kids will enjoy **Castle Amusement Park**, featuring an 80-year-old Dentzel carousel with hand-carved animals. There are also miniature golf courses and a video arcade here. For photo buffs, the

**California Museum of Photography** contains a large collection of photographic equipment, an interactive gallery and walk-through camera!

*Traveling east on I-10 ...*

Just before Palm Springs you'll come across **Hadley's**, the Tiffany's of dried fruit. Shop this warehouse-sized store as you munch on free samples. Hadley's also sells nuts, health food and wine (there is a tasting room). Employees will mail gifts anywhere in the world for you.

*Past the Palm Springs exit, then north on Hwy 62 ...*

Explore the high desert at **Joshua Tree National Monument**, a magnificent and rare desert sanctuary. Sheltered here are some of the most unusual and beautiful plants and wildlife in California, including the Joshua Tree itself.

Want to cool down? The family can easily spend an entire day at **Knott's Soak City U.S.A.**, with 13 waterslides, a wave pool and attractions designed for your youngest. How about a round of golf before check-in? The valley has more than 100 courses for the pro and duffer alike.

## Driving Directions

### From Palm Springs Airport

- Exit the airport onto Tahquitz Canyon Rd.
- Follow Tahquitz Canyon for approximately two miles.
- Turn right onto Indian Canyon.
- Drive approximately 3/4 mile to Tachevah and turn left.
- Drive 1/2 block farther to get onto Palm Canyon and turn right.
- Turn left onto Vereda Sur St, then immediately into the resort's parking lot.

### From Los Angeles, CA

- Take I-10 East out of Riverside to Hwy 111 to Palm Springs.
- Follow 111 (Palm Canyon) for

approximately seven miles into Palm Springs.

- The resort is on the right, just past Denny's restaurant.

### From Phoenix, AZ

- Take I-10 West out of Phoenix for approximately five hours.
- When you get to Coachella Valley, exit at Date Palm.
- Turn left onto Date Palm and go to the first stop light.
- Turn right onto Vista Chino and drive for five miles until you get to Palm Canyon.
- Turn left at Palm Canyon. Travel two more blocks and WorldMark will be on your right side.
