

## Special Needs Unit Features

- Entry and interior doors have at least 32" of clearance
- Visual fire alarms
- Bedrooms have at least 36" access to one bed side
- Bed heights about 25"
- Dining tables have 27½" knee clearance
- 28" x 57" roll-in shower in one-bedroom unit
- Grab bars
- Handheld showerheads
- Roll-under lavatories have 29" knee clearance
- 17" toilets
- Front control oven/stove
- Kitchen sinks have 32" roll-under clearance
- Counter microwave

## Resort Accessible Features

- Accessible parking
- Card key locks
- Elevators
- Accessible routes to all resort facilities
- Lift for pool and spa access
- Compliance kit with TDD unit and visual fire, phone and door knock alarms available

WorldMark Reno is located on level property and has accessible parking, accessible routes to all resort facilities and elevator access to all units. Lobby doors are easy to open and the registration counter is 44" high. A lift is available for pool and spa access.

## Special Needs Units

One-bedroom, one-bathroom

Two-bedroom, two-bathroom

All special needs units have card key lock entry, lever door handles, level thresholds and 32" entry clearance. All interior doorways have at least 32" of clearance. All special needs bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, 17" high toilets, 29" of knee clearance under lavatories and handheld showerheads. The special needs one-bedroom unit has a 28" x 57" roll-in shower; the special needs two-bedroom unit has a 14" tub/shower with a fold down bench. Portable bath benches are available. Bedrooms have at least 36" clearance on one bed side. Kitchens have front control appliances, counter microwaves, 34" counters and 34" sinks with 32" knee clearance. Dining room tables have 27½" of knee clearance and living areas have an open design.

Though all of the standard one- and two-bedroom units have 32" entries and 29" access into the bedrooms, the bathroom door widths and configurations in the standard two-bedroom units will not accommodate even the smallest of wheelchairs. The bathrooms in the standard one-bedroom units are small as well; however, the door width is 27" and a chair narrow enough to enter the room could gain access to both the side of the tub and front of the toilet.
