

Special Needs Unit Features

- All doors at least 33" of clearance
- All doors have lever handles
- Tubs/showers with portable bath benches available
- 29" high roll-under lavatory
- 18" high toilets
- Grab bars
- 26" high beds
- Good access to both bed sides
- Dining room table knee clearance 28"
- Roll-under kitchen sink
- Accessible decks

Running Y is wheelchair-accessible throughout the main lodge, with automatic entry doors and a 36" high check-in counter. Restaurants, health spa and most resort facilities are designed to accommodate wheelchairs. The golf course is mostly level, with paved walkways and gentle slopes. The indoor pool has a lift available to assist mobility-impaired guests. Miles of paved walkways provide access to a scenic wonderland; however, some of these trails can be steep and are not recommended for wheelchairs.

Special Needs Units

Two bedroom, two bathroom

All special needs units have standard key locks, lever door handles and level thresholds. All doorways have at least 33" of clearance. Bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, 18" high toilets, lavatories with knee clearance and standard tub/showers with grab bars, hand-held shower heads and, upon request, portable bath benches with back support. Master beds are 24" high and accessible on both sides. Kitchens boast roll-under sinks with 33" of knee clearance, and all kitchen appliances have front controls and are at accessible heights. Living rooms are open, and 7'x11' decks are accessible through 32" doorways.

The most popular alternatives are one- and two-bedroom units, which have similar layouts to the special needs two-bedroom without roll-under lavatories and interior door widths of just 27". All but two regular one- and two-bedroom units are ground level or have elevator access. The jetted-tub units have stairs and no elevators; the chalet units are not wheelchair accessible.
