

Special Needs Unit Features

- All entry doors have at least 33" of clearance
- All doors have lever handles
- Visual doorbells
- One- and two-bedroom units have 36"x 38" roll-in showers with 2½" thresholds
- Studio, three-bedroom and penthouse units have 33"x 60" roll-in showers with ½" thresholds
- Bed heights about 26"
- 18"- 19" high toilets
- Grab bars
- Portable bath benches available
- Bedrooms have minimum 36" access to one bed side
- Dining room table knee clearance 24"- 25"
- Front control stove/oven
- Counter microwave

All special needs units have card key lock entry, lever door handles, level thresholds and 33" entry clearance. All interior doorways have at least 33" of clearance. Bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, 18"- 19" high toilets, at least 28" of knee clearance under lavatories, handheld showerheads and roll-in showers with fold-down benches. Portable bath benches with back support are available. The special needs one- and two-bedroom units have 36"x 38" roll-in showers with 2½" thresholds. The special needs studio, three-bedroom and penthouse have 33"x 60" roll-in showers with ½" thresholds. Bedrooms have at least 36" clearance on one bed side. Kitchens have front control appliances, 34" counters, 34" roll-under sinks with 28" knee clearance and counter microwaves. Dining room tables have 25" of knee clearance; penthouse unit tables have 24" knee clearance. Living rooms are accessible. The 5'x 8' and 6'x 14' decks have at least 32" access and 1½" thresholds.

All of the units at Seaside have elevator access, 32" entrances, and 29" clearance on all interior doors. The most accessible alternative to the special needs units are the standard studio, one-bedroom and penthouse units due to better bedside access and bathrooms spacious enough to accommodate most wheelchairs.
