Special Needs Unit Features

- All doorways have at least 33” of clearance
- All doors have lever handles
- Tubs/showers with portable bath benches with back support; some units have roll-in showers
- All units have roll-under lavatories
- 18” high toilets
- Grab bars
- 25” high beds
- Excellent maneuvering space around beds
- Accessible kitchen appliances
- Roll-under kitchen sinks with 25” of knee clearance
- Dining room table knee clearance 25”
- 29” wide doorway access to patios

St. George has a wheelchair accessible check-in counter, exercise room and recreation center. There are elevators and paved paths to all resort facilities. A lift is available to assist mobility impaired guests into and out of both the outdoor pool and outdoor spa. The surrounding property is level to gently sloping.

Special Needs Units

One bedroom, one bathroom
Two bedroom, two bathroom
Three bedroom, two bathroom
Penthouse three bedroom, 2 ½ bathroom

All special needs units feature card key lock entry, lever door handles and level thresholds. All doorways have at least 33” of clearance, and large bedrooms provide good wheelchair access to beds. Spacious bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, 18” high toilets, and lavatories with 29” of knee clearance. The one- and three-bedroom units have standard tubs/showers with hand-held shower heads, grab bars and portable bath benches; the two-bedroom and penthouse units have roll-in showers. The kitchens sport sinks with 25” of knee clearance, front control appliances and microwaves 36” off the floor.

Standard one- and three-bedroom units are the best alternatives to the special needs units because they have spacious designs and floor plans nearly identical to their special needs counterparts without extra modifications such as grab bars.
