

## Special Needs Unit Features

- All doors have at least 31” of clearance
- All doors have lever handles
- Tub/shower with portable bath benches
- Roll-under lavatory
- 19” high toilets
- Grab bars
- 27” high beds
- Roll-under kitchen counter with 25” of knee clearance
- Dining room table knee clearance 25” in one-bedroom unit, 28” in two-bedroom
- TDD unit available

## Resort Features

- Accessible underground parking (6’4” maximum height)
- Accessible route to recreation center and swim pool (located across the street)
- Portable bath bench with back support available

The Canadian features accessible garage parking with a maximum 6’4” vehicle height, elevators and accessible routes to the shared recreation facilities across the street. Because of its urban setting, this property must first be accessed via steps up to the WorldMark check-in desk. After that, guests are provided keys which will allow them to enter the building and even the check-in area via wheelchair-accessible routes. These keys are also necessary to enter the parking garage and operate the elevators.

## Special Needs Units

One bedroom, one bathroom  
Two bedroom, one bathroom

All special needs units feature standard key lock entry, lever door handles and level thresholds. All doorways have at least 31” of clearance. Bathrooms are equipped with 19” high toilets and lavatories with 26” to 27” of knee clearance. Standard tub/showers have hand-held shower heads, grab bars and portable bath benches with no back supports. Bedrooms are small but have 32” of access on at least one side of the bed. Living rooms and kitchens have compact designs but are accessible. Kitchens have small work spaces with 25” of knee clearance; the dining room table’s knee clearances is 25” in the one-bedroom unit and 28” in the two-bedroom.

None of the standard units are recommended for mobility impaired guests since door widths are only 28” and the bathrooms are too small to accommodate wheelchairs.
