Special Needs Unit Features

- Card key lock entry
- All doors have at least 31" of clearance
- All doors have lever handles
- Two-bedroom penthouse has a 48"x59" roll-in shower
- One of the two-bedroom units has a 33"x37" roll-in shower
- 28" roll-under lavatories
- 18" toilets in most units
- Grab bars
- A portable bath bench with back support is available
- 24"-25" high beds
- 1"-2" thresholds for decks
- Roll-under kitchen sinks
- Dining room table knee clearance 26"
- Front control stove/range
- Counter microwaves
- Visual fire alarms in most units

WorldMark Las Vegas offers handicap parking, a lobby with a power-assist door and a lowered section at the check-in counter for disabled access. There are accessible routes to all resort facilities, as well as a lift for access to the pool, spa and lazy river. This property also boasts a shuttle bus with a wheelchair lift to ferry guests to casinos and shopping. The resort features Braille signage and has one TTY unit available. All but one special needs unit are equipped with visual fire alarms.

Special Needs Units

- One bedroom, one bathroom
- Two bedroom, two bathroom
- Two-bedroom, two-bathroom penthouse
- Three bedroom, two bathroom

All special needs units feature card key lock entry, lever door handles and level thresholds. All entries doors have at least 33" of clearance, and interior door widths of at least 31". Bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, 18" toilets, 28" of knee clearance under lavatories and tub/showers with grab bars and shower curtains. (Except for the two-bedroom penthouse unit, which also has a 48"x59" roll-in shower; and one of the two-bedroom units, which has a 33"x37" roll-in shower but only 15" toilets.) A portable bath bench with back support is also available. Bedrooms have at least 31" of clearance on one bed side, except the one-bedroom units, which only have about 27" access on one bed side. The kitchens have sinks with 27" of knee clearance, front control appliances and counter microwaves. Living areas are open, and decks have at least 32" access with thresholds that range between 1"-2".

If special needs units are not available, the two- and three-bedroom penthouses are the best alternatives because of their spacious bedrooms and bathrooms. The standard two-bedroom units also have bathrooms large enough to accommodate most wheelchairs and at least 31" access on one bed side.
