Things to See and Do in Wolf Creek

WorldMark at Wolf Creek is nestled against the Wasatch Mountains in the magnificent Rockies and Utah's famed snow country! Just five miles away is Powder Mountain Ski Resort, the local favorite. Powder Mountain has an average annual snowfall of 500 inches, more than 30 designated runs and a vertical drop of 1,980 feet. With seven lifts, 1,600 skiable (and boardable) acres and night skiing, the lift lines are short here, so you can get in more runs. You'll also find Snowbasin just 15 miles from WorldMark at Wolf Creek. Snowbasin-which hosted the 2002 Olympic downhill events-has 1,800 acres of bowls, glades, trails and chutes. With 39 runs and 2,400 vertical feet, Snowbasin has everything you need, whether you're an expert skier or a beginning snowboarder.

Non-skiers will also love WorldMark at Wolf Creek, even in winter. Many people head to Utah simply to play in the glorious light powder. The **Ogden Valley** gives you unparalleled opportunities for tubing, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing and snowmobiling. You can also skate year round at The **Ice Sheet** in nearby Ogden. This covered, Olympic-size arena is an incredible place to skate due to the huge picture windows looking out onto the Wasatch Mountains.

Winter's not the only game in town. In summer, head back to the Wasatch Mountains for incredible hiking, biking and horseback riding. This range is crisscrossed with maintained trails, ranging from beginner to advanced. A favorite intermediate hike in this part of Utah is the nine-mile-roundtrip Indian Trail, which starts at the east end of Ogden and climbs up to Ogden Canyon. Trail maps, trailhead locations and hiking information can be obtained through the U.S. Forest Service by calling (801) 625-5306. Or saddle up and fall into line on a guided trail ride from Eden, WorldMark at Wolf Creek's home address. Bicycles can also be rented in Eden, and bike maps and information are available: call The Golden Spike Empire at (801) 627-8288.

Golf is another big draw in this part of the country. And, again, you won't be spending much time in your car to get to it—Wolf Creek Golf Resort is right outside your door! This beautiful mountain course gives you 150 acres of greens and fairways, not to mention views in every direction. The 7,000yard, par-72 course challenges golfers with many long par fives, heavilysanded bunker approaches and dropoffs—all in the midst of lakes, streams and trees. Wolf Creek Golf Resort includes a pro shop, golf instruction and restaurants. A little farther afield there's **El Monte Golf Course**, located at the mouth of Ogden Canyon, with picturesque views of the Wasatch Mountains and the Ogden River.

Other area activities include scenic drives, hot-air balloon rides, special events, and fishing, water-skiing and boating at the **Pineview Reservoir**, just a few miles from Wolf Creek. And don't forget the **city of Ogden** and its many attractions (performing arts, galleries, museums, amusement parks, planetarium, city parks, shopping, dining, nightlife ...). Driving Directions

From Salt Lake City, UT

- Take I-15 North approx. 41miles to Exit 344 (12th St) in Ogden.
- At the end of the exit, turn left onto Hwy 39 (12th St) and travel east through Ogden and Ogden Canyon for a total of 13 miles until you come to Hwy 158 and the Pineview Reservoir Spillway.
- Following the brown recreation signs to Wolf Creek and Powder Mountain, turn left onto Hwy 158 and cross over the reservoir spillway.
- Wind around the reservoir for approx. four miles, until you reach a fork in the road.

- Veer to the left here, staying on Hwy 158.
- You will come to a stop sign. Proceed straight through the intersection and continue approximately 1 1/2 miles.
- WorldMark at Wolf Creek is about 1/4 mile after the first set of units (Wolf Lodge).
- Turn left onto the property, just before you reach the Wolf Creek Golf and Clubhouse. The check-in office is located at 3618 N Wolf Creek Dr.

From the north

• Take Exit 344 (12th St) in Ogden, turn east onto Hwy 39 (12th St) and follow **bold** directions from Salt Lake.
