

## Special Needs Unit Features

- All doors have at least 33” of clearance
- All doors have lever handles
- Portable bath seats are available
- Two-bedroom units have roll-in showers
- Roll-under lavatories
- 18” high toilets
- Grab bars
- 27” high beds
- Two-bedroom units have excellent maneuvering space around bed
- Front control stove/range in studio one-bedroom units
- Roll-under kitchen sinks
- Dining table knee clearance 28”
- Accessible patios

## Resort Accessible Features

- Accessible parking
- Accessible route to recreation center and outdoor pool area
- Lower check-in counter
- TDD units available

**W**olf Creek is situated on a hillside and has steep surrounding terrain. Most resort facilities and accommodations, however, are located in level to moderately sloping areas. The resort has handicapped parking and accessible routes to the swimming pool, spa and recreation center. The check-in area has a lowered counter for disabled access.

## Special Needs Units

- Studio, one bathroom
- One bedroom, one bathroom
- Two bedroom, two bathroom

All special needs units have standard key lock entry (all units are being re-keyed in 2004 to the electronic-lock systems in late 2004), lever door handles and level thresholds. All doorways have at least 33” of clearance. Studio and one-bedroom unit bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, 18” high toilets, lavatories with 27” of knee clearance and standard tubs/showers with grab bars. A portable bath bench with back support is also available. Two bedroom units have 36”x45” roll-in showers, grab bars, lavatories with 27” knee clearance and 18” high toilets. Bedrooms have at least 31” of clearance on both sides of the bed; the two-bedroom units are considerably more spacious. The kitchens all have sinks with 27” to 29” of knee clearance, and studio and one-bedroom units have front-control appliances. Living areas are very open, and the large patios have at least 30” wide doorways with a 2” lip.

Though not specifically designed for access, the ramped groundfloor two-bedroom units boast 33” wide entries and bathrooms large enough to accommodate most wheelchairs. Bedroom and bathroom doors, however, only provide 27” of clearance.
