

## No Special Needs Units

- Entry and interior doors have at least 32" of clearance
- Visual fire and doorbell alarms
- Bedrooms have at least 36" access to at least one bed side
- Bed heights about 26"
- Dining tables in two- and three-bedroom units have at least 27½" knee clearance; penthouse dining table has 26" clearance
- 30"x 60" roll-in showers in two two-bedroom units; remainder have 16" tubs
- Handheld showerheads
- 18" - 19" Toilets
- Grab bars
- Front control oven/stove
- Kitchen sinks with 28" roll-under clearance
- Counter microwave

## Resort Accessible Features

- Accessible parking
- Card key locks
- Elevators
- 30" high section of registration counter
- Accessible routes to all resort facilities
- Lift for pool and spa access
- Compliance kit with TDD unit and visual fire, phone and door knock alarms available

WorldMark Windsor is located on level property and has accessible routes to all resort facilities and ground floor or elevator access to all units. A lift is available for pool and spa access. The registration counter has a 30" high section.

## Special Needs Units

- One-bedroom, one-bathroom
- Two-bedroom, two-bathroom
- Three-bedroom, two-bathroom
- Three-bedroom, three-bathroom penthouse

All special needs units have card key lock entry, lever door handles, level thresholds and 32" entry clearance. All interior doorways have at least 33" of clearance. All special needs bathrooms are equipped with grab bars, 18" - 19" high toilets, at least 28" of knee clearance under lavatories and tub/showers with grab bars, handheld showerheads and shower curtains. The special needs three-bedroom unit does not have a roll-under lavatory. Two of the special needs two-bedroom units have 30"x 60" roll-in showers. Bedrooms have at least 36" clearance on one bed side. Kitchens have front control appliances, counter microwaves, 34" counters and 34" sinks with at least 28" knee clearance. Dining room tables have at least 27½" of knee clearance in the two- and three-bedroom units. Table clearance is 26" in the penthouse and access is blocked to the dining room table in the one-bedroom unit. Some living room layouts are crowded. The 5'x 7' and 6'x 14' decks have at least 30" access and 1½" thresholds.

Though all of the standard units at this property feature ground floor or elevator access, 32" entries and interior door widths, the studio, three-bedroom deluxe, and penthouse are the most accessible alternatives because they have good access to bedsides and bathrooms large enough to accommodate most wheelchairs.
